
# AGENDA ITEMS

#### **Current Tasks**

**Targeted Probe & Educate (TPE)** 

 Some members reported they are getting results faster. However, it's taking a while to get to the next round. AG reminded to email to the Medical Review TPE Mailbox for specific guestions concerning TPE, J15HHPROBEANDEDUCATION@CGSADMIN.COM.

**KEEP, START, or CHANGE Roundtable** 

- myCGS: Members commented the portal works great.
- Website: AG members echoed that CGS is a preferred site and providers are often directed to the website. Suggestion made to keep the tools we have, and the group is fond of the user-friendly navigation and easy to understand content.
- Provider Contact Center: No feedback.
- Education: Recommendation to include education concerning the Change of Ownership rule that now applies to hospice.

**Suggested Topics** 

- Recovery Auditor Contractor (RAC) Webinar Clarification: During a recent partner webinar between CGS and Performant, it was mentioned by the RA that recent RAC denials surround timely initiation of care. This is a condition of participation and historically has never been viewed as a condition of payment. This has been shared with the RAC after CGS received several inquiries. The RAC is working with CMS on this matter. Information will be shared as it becomes available. The group suggested adding a clarification to the previous event. If this is not a possibility, we've asked the RAC to provide an update if available on the next event scheduled for July 30th. Group advised this is not a CGS matter but a RAC matter.
- Change in Certifying Physician (FAQ update and related article): Group asked about recent discussions on this topic and an article that another Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC) published. Nykesha advised the group all the HHH MACs have been working with CMS on this topic and were creating a united article. The article was in the process of being added to the webpage at the time. It has since been published, as well as an update to a related frequently asked question (FAQ). A group member suggested an update to the HH Additional Documentation Request (ADR) checklist.
