Welcome

Purpose and Goals

The primary function of the Advisory Group is to assist the contractor in the creation, implementation, and review of provider education strategies and efforts. The Advisory Group provides input and feedback on training topics, provider education materials, and dates and locations of provider education workshops and events. The group also identifies salient provider education issues and recommends effective means of information dissemination to all appropriate providers and their staff, including the use of the PCC to disseminate information to providers.

POE AG Recommendations

CGS actions taken on member education recommendations

Curtis introduced various POE team member who reviewed the member education recommendations received during the December 2020 meeting and how CGS responded.

- MDPP Education Patsy Schwenk discussed the breakout groups led by the JBS consulting firm during the last POE AG meeting. Members provided feedback on the discussion topics of the Medicare Diabetes Prevention Program, Preventive Services and Chronic Care Management. CGS education on these topics will now be focused on the J15 provider community. The Ohio State University (OSU) helped JBS create a video on these topics that will eventually be placed on our YouTube page. Juan Lumpkin highlighted and thanked POE AG members for sharing education links on the topic also.
- OPD Education Patsy Schwenk shared that a webinar on Outpatient Department Prior
 Authorization services was held on August 24, 2021 and it highlighted the new services that
 have been added to the service list. The webinar also included details about the exemption
 process. The webinar is also on our website for review. During this time Patsy also let the
 group know that medical review has restarted the Target Probe and Educate (TPE) reviews
 and the codes that will be part of process are on our website.





Current Tasks

Member feedback on our last quarters' education events (June 9th thru September 8th, 2021)

One member spoke very highly of the claim overlap webinar "Who Pays Who?" that was conducted in early September. They stated the handout material was very helpful and enjoyed the polling questions and case studies. Providers asked for more time to be added in some topics and maybe even a transcript of all the questions and answers being sent to attendees would be beneficial.

2022 In Person Event Planning

POE staff asked the POE AG members for topics for planning purposes. The event is scheduled to have both in person and online attendance available. Topics suggested were:
